**GOVERNMENT'S MOTION FOR ONE LEVEL REDUCTION  
FOR ACCEPTANCE OF RESPONSIBILITY**

The United States of America, through Assistant United States Attorney Kevin Leitch, hereby moves that the defendant's total offense level be decreased by one additional level for early acceptance of responsibility under United States Sentencing Guidelines § 3E1.1(b). In support of its motion, the Government states that the defendant has assisted authorities in the investigation and prosecution of his own misconduct by timely notifying authorities of his intention to enter a plea of guilty, thereby permitting the Government to avoid preparing for trial and permitting the Government and the Court to allocate their resources efficiently.

Accordingly, the Government would ask the Court to decrease defendant's offense level by one additional level, as provided for in United States Sentencing Guideline § 3E1.1(b).
